- VVOB stands for 'commitment' to achieve the Sustainable Development Goals by 2030.
- VVOB stands for 'integrity' and 'mutual respect' in working with our partner organisations across 10 countries / 3 continents.
- VVOB stands for 'quality' and 'innovation' of everything we do in our effort to improve education worldwide.

#### **VVOB in Zambia**

In Zambia, VVOB is working in partnership with the Ministry of General Education (MoGE). We are building capacity on Early Childhood Education (ECE) and Teaching at the Right Level (TaRL).


Our key focus points in ECE are 'Learning through Play' and 'Emergent Literacy'. We are currently reaching 8 provinces with our work in ECE.

The evidence-based TaRL approach helps learners in Grades 3, 4 and 5 to develop basic reading and numeracy skills. TaRL (or Catch Up - as it is known in Zambia) now reaches more than 2000 primary schools and close to 300.000 learners spread over 9 provinces.

Our ambition is to support MoGE in scaling the 'Learning through Play', 'Emergent Literacy' and 'Teaching at the Right Level' work. We are also working with government to support out of school adolescents.

# Responsibilities of the Fleet Officer

The Fleet Officer is, in consultation with the Operations Manager, responsible for assisting in coordination of transport for the VVOB Zambia Office. This position will be responsible for adhering to all relevant VVOB policies and regulations while maintaining smooth and efficient transport management and coordination within Lusaka and other Provinces. S/he will report directly to the Operations Manager. This is not a driver position.





#### You will:

- Coordinate all Fleet management related issues by maintaining an effective and efficient transport management within VVOB Zambia.
- Responsible at all times for ensuring that all fleet is adequately Insured, Road Taxes and other statutory payments made, repairs and services are done on time.
- Responsible for ensuring that the Vehicles are well serviced and maintained.
- Timely handling of submission of all provincial insurance claims
- Manage car hire contracts and ensure that they operate in line with VVOB Zambia vehicle use policy.
- Ensure the Fleet vehicle policies are in place and adhered to.
- Training of drivers in matters related to fleet policy.

# If you're our Fleet Officer, your workweek at the office will include the following highlights:









- Coordinate travel schedules, and trips/transport within and out of the Provinces for both Project fleet and hired vehicles on a weekly/monthly basis.
- You prepare the monthly reports for onward submission for review and approval by the Operations Manager.
- Responsible for coordinating and requesting for waivers for vehicles where needed.
- Ensure that the project Fuel Accounts are reconciled and replenished on

- Responsible for monitoring all project vehicles on Geotab and report to the Operations Manager where applicable.
- Responsible for monitoring fuel/vehicle usage analysis and reconciliations and attending to any deviations from the expected normal consumption.
